2. Whether the Tahasildar could have proceeded with the proceedings under Section 138 of the Maharashtra Land Revenue Code, 1966, despite the pendency of the Civil Suit before the Civil Court, warrants consideration.
3. Issue notice to the Respondents, returnable on 26 August 2025.
4. Learned AGP waives service of notice on behalf of Respondent Nos.7 and 8.
5. In addition to notice through Court, the Petitioners are at liberty to serve Respondent Nos.1 to 6 by private service and file an affidavit of service.
6. In the meanwhile, there shall be an ad-interim relief in terms of prayer clause (d) of the Petition.
