1. On 14th July, 2025, notice was issued to the respondents making the same returnable on 26th August, 2025. Hamdast was permitted. In addition to Court notice, private notice was also permitted.

2. On 26th August, 2025, the respondent No.3 i.e. the

original complainant was present in person. He sought time to engage an Advocate. On his request, the matter was kept on 15th September, 2025. Thereafter, the matter was listed on 19th September, 2025. None appeared for the respondent No.3 on 19th September, 2025.

6. Stand over to **16th October, 2025**. To be placed on the Supplementary Board.

7. Interim relief, granted earlier, to continue, until further orders.
