1. Heard Mr. Sherkhane, learned Counsel appearing for the Petitioners. Also heard Mr. Chipte, learned Counsel appearing for the Respondent No.2, who, instead of obtaining instruction and apprising this Court, as to whether a soft instalment can be permitted to the Petitioners to repay the loan, has argued that the
