Heard Mr. Sandeep Sherkhane, learned counsel appearing for the Petitioner, who submits that in terms of the order dated 4th August, 2025 passed by this Court, his client has deposited the amount of Rs.50,000/- by means of a cheque dated 20th August, 2025. However, no schedule of repayment of the loan, based on installments has yet been furnished to his client by the Respondent No.1-Bank.

2. Mr. Prafull Chipte, learned counsel appearing for the Respondent No.2 is present and submits that no settlement could be arrived at in the matter between the parties. Mr. Chipte, however, could not inform this Court as to the specific reason why,

schedule of re-payment of the loan on installment basis could not be issued to the Petitioner in terms of the order dated 4th August, 2025.

3. It appears from the record that the Petitioner is willing to repay the loan amount and is seeking facility of installment payment.

4. At the request of the learned counsel for the Respondent No.2, three weeks time is granted to the Bank to issue a fresh schedule of re-payment of the loan amount on installment basis, with interest. After receipt of the schedule of such re-payment, it would be open for the Petitioner to adequately respond to the same.

5. List again on 3rd October, 2025.

6. Interim order, granted earlier, if any, to continue till then.
