1. Heard the learned Counsel for the parties.
2. This Petition is filed seeking a direction to the Respondent No.1, Divisional Joint Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Pune, to hear and decide the Revision Application No. 295 of 2025, preferred by the Petitioner against an order passed by the Deputy Registrar.
3. The learned Counsel for the Respondent Nos. 2 and 3 submits that the Respondent Nos. 2 and 3 are not averse to the expedite hearing and final disposal of the Revision Application No. 295 of 2025.
