The learned Additional Government Pleader submits on instructions that, in the light of the observations of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in paragraph 9 of the order dated 16.09.2025, the State has moved a praecipe before the Registrar (Judicial-I) for seeking appropriate orders from the Hon'ble The Chief Justice of the Bombay High Court for clubbing all the matters filed at Nagpur, Aurangabad, Kolhapur and Mumbai, before a particular Bench.
