



3. Mr. Mhaispurkar, thus, seeks leave to withdraw this petition with liberty to raise all the contentions in the said appeal which is subjudice before the learned Joint Charity Commissioner.
4. In view of the subsequent development, the petition stands disposed as withdrawn with liberty to raise all the contentions which are available in law in the said appeal pending before the Joint Charity Commissioner.
5. Learned Joint Charity Commissioner is requested to decide the said appeal on its own merits and in accordance with law.
6. All contentions of all the parties are kept open for consideration.
