I, Mr. Shishir Vivekanad Shetty, Age: 46 years, Indian Inhabitant, the Petitioner above named having address as 6A/302, Alica Nagar, Lokhandwala Township, Kandivali (East), Mumbai – 400 101 and I Mrs. Sangeeta Ravi Nee Parmar, Age: 46 years, Indian Inhabitant, the Respondent above named having address as Flat No. 604, Tower No. 2, Spring Grove Towers CHSL, Lokhandwala Township, Akruli Road, Kandivali (East), Mumbai – 400 101, current residing at 10006, Block No. 4, Sapphir Heights, Akruli Road, Lokhandwala Township, Kandivali (East), Mumbai – 400 101. We say that we are executing the present consent terms for the terms recorded hereinafter:

1. That the present Petition is preferred by the Petitioner challenging the order dated 08.10.2025 passed by Ld. Family Court at Bandra below Exhibit – 42 in Petition No. A-742 of 2025 wherein the Ld. Family Court had granted

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access to minor son Rudra on 29.10.2025, 30.10.2025 & 31.10.2025 from 11:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.

2. That the matter was listed before the Hon'ble High Court on 17.10.2025 and it is mutually agreed between the parties that the Order dated 08.10.2025 shall be modified and the access to the minor son shall be given to the Petitioner on 18.10.2025, inside the Children Complex, Family Court, Bandra between 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. and on 30.10.2025 at Children Complex, Family Court, Bandra between 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.
3. That the present consent terms, is executed to limited purpose for availing child access during the Diwali vacation and the prevailing weekly access condition shall not be modified and/or construed to be superseded by execution of the present consent terms as provided by the Ld. Family Court.
4. That it is also agreed between the parties that the visitation/Access provided to the Petitioner inside the Children Complex, Family Court at Bandra and the child

shall not be accompanied inside by Caretaker (Nanny) and/or Mother and/or any other person who is coming along with the child to Children Complex, Family Court at Bandra.

5. The Petitioner has agreed to pay Rs. **2,000/-** towards travelling expenses for the access provided on 18.10.2025 and 30.10.2025.
