The primary grievance expressed in this Writ Petition pertains to failure on the part of the State to provide police protection and also on account of non-compliance of the order of the Tahsildar issued on 18th November, 2022, directing handing over of the possession of the mortgaged property to the Petitioners. We have noticed that the directions sought for is apparently in execution of a Certificate of Recovery which has attained finality.

2. The Borrower is still in possession of the property. However, the Borrower has not been impleaded as a party to this proceeding.

3. Be that as it may, at the request of Ms. Rupali Shinde, learned AGP appearing for the State, four weeks time is granted for obtaining instructions.

4. Copy of the Petition be furnished to Ms. Shinde, learned AGP.
5. The Petitioners are also given liberty to implead the Borrower as a party Respondent, if so advised.
6. At the request of the learned AGP, this matter is directed to be listed alongwith Writ Petitions (L) Nos.27329 of 2025 and 29743 of 2025 on 8th December, 2025.
