

3. The aforementioned online application has been moved by the petitioner on 16th September 2024. In the said online application, there are various columns which an applicant is required to fill up. In support of his claim that his name should be included in the voters list, the petitioner has furnished the proof of residence, that is, the Voter ID of his brother. It seems that the petitioner is not having an Aadhar Card or a driving licence or a PAN Card or an Indian Passport. Besides all this, it seems that the petitioner approached this Court by filing this writ petition only on 9th September 2025. It is clear that the petitioner came to this Court through this writ petition at a belated stage. There is no statement made by the petitioner regarding the reasons why he did not approach this Court in the last one year.

4. In view of the aforesaid, Writ Petition No. 14799 of 2025 is dismissed.
