1) By this Petition, the Petitioner essentially seeks in prayer clause (c), quashing and setting aside of the Order dated 1st November 2025, passed by the Respondent No.1-Returning Officer and Deputy Charity Commissioner. As far as other relief is concerned, i.e. the relief sought in prayer clause (b), learned Counsel for the Petitioner does not press the said relief. He, however, seeks liberty to take appropriate steps *vis-a-vis* the said relief before the appropriate forum. Accordingly, liberty is

granted.

2) Ms. Pooja Patil, learned A.G.P., on instructions of Mr. Ashfaq Khan on behalf of the Returning Officer, Mr. Rahul Dhavan (Deputy Charity Commissioner), states that the letter/order dated 1st November 2025, will be withdrawn forthwith. Statement accepted.
