1. Heard the petitioner, who appears in person, Mr. Shekhar Jagtap, learned counsel for the respondent No.1 – Bar Council of India and the respondent No. 2, who also appears in person.

2. At the outset, we may note, that the petitioner, who appears in person, does not press prayer clauses - 'A', 'B' and 'C'. He only presses for prayer clause 'D' i.e. a direction to the respondent No.1 – Bar Council of India to expeditiously hear and dispose of the appeal filed by the respondent No.3, within a time bound period.
