1. Since the statutory appeal filed by the petitioners challenging order passed under Section 78A of the Maharashtra Cooperative Societies Act, 1960 is pending, limited protection till the disposal of the appeal needs to be granted considering gravity of charges levelled against the petitioners.
2. Hence, until further orders, there shall be interim relief in terms of prayer clause (b).
3. It is made clear that pendency of present writ petition shall not preclude the appellate authority from deciding the appeal on its own merits.
4. After signing but before uploading the order on the website, at 3.00 p.m., learned Advocate for the petitioner has placed on

record a copy of order passed by the appellate authority in the appeal, served at 2.38 p.m., dismissing petitioners' appeal. Hence, for period of four weeks from today, the Administrator shall not take charge of the society.

5. The writ petition accordingly stands disposed of. No costs.
