ORDER:

1. Not on board. Taken on the production board.
2. This appeal is urgently circulated as there is an apprehension that the amount of compensation shall be disbursed to respondent no. 1. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the suit is filed on the ground that even the appellant has the right in the property that is acquired. She submits that according to the appellant, the amount is not yet disbursed.
