Learned Appellate Court shall ensure that if required Regular Civil Appeal be taken up on day to day basis for disposal within the aforementioned time frame and be decided strictly in accordance with law considering the exigency expressed by Mr. Walimbe, learned Advocate for the Co-operative Housing Society.

- 9.** Registry is directed to accept the Vakalatnama of Mr. Naqvi, learned Advocate for Respondent.
- 10.** With the above directions, Contempt Petition is disposed.
