CONSENT TERMS

On behalf of both the above Parties, the said Consent Terms which are mutually agreed by both the Parties and thereby it has been reduced in writing as under ;

1) That the Applicant has filed the aforesaid Misc. Civil Application against the Respondent above-named, wherein praying for transfer of Family Court Divorce Petition No. A-394 of 2024, before this Hon'ble Court; which has been pending before the Family Court Thane at Thane, filed by Respondent herein, against the Applicant herein;

2) After arguing the said matter for some time, both the Parties i.e. the Applicant and the Respondent have mutually decided to settle the matter between them amicably and thereby agreed to the following terms and conditions enumerated as under;

3) That as the Respondent herein has filed the divorce petition against the Applicant herein on the ground of cruelty before the Hon'ble Family Court Thane at Thane, vide Petition No. A - 394 of 2024. Thereafter as mentioned earlier Applicant herein had filed the present Application for transfer of the said divorce petition at Malegaon, to where she is presently staying and residing alongwith her Parents therein.

4) That in the said Application before this Hon'ble Court now at present the applicant and respondent herein have mutually decided to

settle the said matter amicably by converting the Lower Court i.e. Family Court Thane, into mutual consent divorce therein.

5) That in view of above settlement, both the Parties agreed that the Respondent - husband agreed to give and pay lumpsum amount of Rs. 4 Lakhs (In words Rupees Four Lakhs only) vide Demand Draft or Pay Order, towards the permanent alimony / maintenance to the Applicant - wife for past, present & future to the Applicant herein.

5) Both the Parties further agreed that the Respondent has agreed to pay the said amount of Rs. 4 Lakhs to Applicant - wife before the Hon'ble Family Court Thane in Divorce Petition No. 394 of 2024.

6) There is no other petition or criminal case or proceedings are pending between applicant and respondent in any court in respect of their marriage or marriage disputes in any court whatsoever.

7) That both the Parties further agrees that the applicant and respondent further agree to co-operate with each other in respect of the proceedings of conversion of divorce petition into a mutual consent divorce petition on the next date of hearing i.e. 06th November, 2025 or the adjourned date in November 2025 thereof.

8) That present consent terms are binding upon both the Parties which has been reduced in writing without any force or coercion on both the Parties herein.

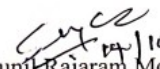

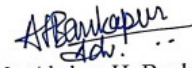
