CONSENT TERMS

The Parties have agreed to dispose off the present proceedings on the following terms and conditions:

1. The Respondent agrees and undertakes to withdraw the proceedings bearing No. C.C. No.358/DV/2024, filed before the Ld. JMFC 67th Court at Borivali forthwith.
2. The Parties undertake to convert the divorce proceedings bearing Petition No. A- 367 of 2025, pending before the Ld. 4th Family Court at Bandra, Mumbai, into a Petition for divorce by mutual consent on the next date viz. 27th October 2025.
3. The Petitioner/Applicant undertakes to pay one-time lumpsum amount of Rs. 25,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Lakhs only) to the Respondent towards her claim of alimony/maintenance for the Respondent and minor son. The said amount shall be paid to the Respondent on the date of

- passing the Judgment of dissolution of marriage by way Demand Draft/NEFT/RTGS in the name of the Respondent.
4. The Parties are joint owners with respect to flat bearing no. B - 605 situated at Yashobhoomi Construction, Wadmukhwadi, Pune. It is agreed that the Applicant has paid for the purchase of the flat in its entirety. The Respondent undertakes to Gift her 50% share in the flat bearing no. B- 605, situated at Yashobhoomi Construction, Wadmukhwadi, Pune, in favour of the Applicant prior to the passing of the judgment of dissolution of their marriage. It is agreed by and between the Parties that the Applicant shall bear the expenses for the Stamp Duty, Registration fees and travelling expenses of the Respondent for the purpose of registering the Gift Deed.
 5. The Parties agree, declare and undertake that they are in possession of their personal belongings, items, documents and streedhan and have no further claims pending against each other and/or their family members, for past, present or future with respect to movable/immovable, tangible/intangible assets owned or to be owned by either of them.
 6. The Parties agree and declare that they withdraw all allegations made against each other and their family members and shall withdraw all/any police complaints or any complaints made before any Authority prior to the passing of the decree of dissolution of their marriage.
 7. The Parties agree that the custody of minor son shall remain with the Mother and the Father shall avail of access of their



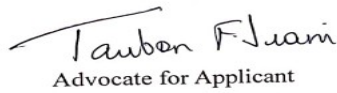
minor son as and when he is able to with prior intimation to the Mother.

8. The Parties agree and declare that they will endeavour to fulfil all the compliances mentioned herein on or before 27.10.2025 i.e. the next date fixed in the Divorce Petition before the Hon'ble Family Court, Bandra.
9. The Parties pray that the captioned proceedings be disposed of in terms of these consent terms and conditions and the same form part of the order of this Hon'ble Court.

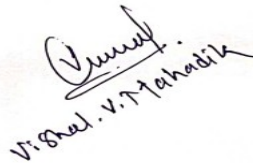

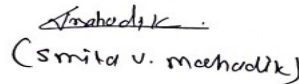
