1. Ms. Naik, learned counsel for the applicant submits that this matter has been referred to her by the Legal Aid Committee of the High Court. In the cause title, it has been mentioned specifically that 'IN THE MATTER OF ARTICLE ____, OF THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA, 1950'. She is seeking liberty to amend the application.

2. On 9 September 2025 and 26 September 2025, when this matter was called out, none appeared on behalf of the applicant. Thereafter, on 7 October 2025, junior advocate appeared on instructions of Ms. Anu Naik and sought an adjournment.
