1. By the present application, the applicant is seeking transfer of Writ Petition No.2366 of 2024 from the Principal Bench of the Bombay High Court to High Court of Bombay at Goa.

2. Ms. Jagtap, learned counsel appearing for the respondent submits that she has instructions from the concerned officer that they will have no objection if the matter is transferred from the Principal Bench of the Bombay High Court to High Court of Bombay at Goa and the matter be heard on merits.

3. In view of the statement being made by learned counsel

appearing for the respondent, the Misc. Civil Application stands allowed in terms of prayer clause (b) which reads as under:-
