**ORDER:**

1. Heard learned counsels for the parties. After hearing the matter for sometime, learned counsel for defendant no.2 submits that defendant no.2 is agreeable to proceed with the hearing of notice of motion finally. She agrees that ad interim relief which was stayed by order dated 30<sup>th</sup> December 2024, can continue during the pendency of notice of motion.
