1. Interim Application has been preferred seeking permission to serve the Respondent Nos. 1, 2 and 4 by substituted service in the newspaper which is circulating in the locality in which the Respondent Nos. 1, 2 and 4 reside.

Learned Counsel appearing for the Applicant submits that the Respondent No. 1's last known address is in Dubai, UAE and Respondent Nos. 2 and 4 in Ontario, Canada and seeks permission for publication in Gulf News, Khaleej Times, Toronto Sun and Toronto Star as far as Respondent Nos. 2 and 4 are concerned. 3. Let the Respondent Nos. 1, 2 and 4 be served by substituted service under Order-V Rule-20 of CPC. The service to be effected within a period of eight weeks from today. Interim Application is allowed.

4. Interim/Ad-interim relief granted earlier, if any, to continue till the next date.
