ORDER:

1. Learned counsels for the parties submit that the parties would make an attempt to amicably resolve the dispute. In the event, the parties are unable to resolve the dispute amicably, parties would make an attempt to atleast arrive at some interim arrangement to work out the dispute during the pendency of the suit.

2. Learned counsel for respondent no.2, submits that he will

take instructions whether the respondent would cooperate for putting an end to the dispute by executing the PAAA agreements in favour of original members and complete the terms and conditions of the development agreement.

5. Till the next date, the parking space in dispute shall not be allotted to any other member of the society.
