5) In view thereof and considering the reasons stated in the Application, the Applicant Nos.1 and 2 are permitted to withdraw 25% of the award amount of their share with proportionate interest subject to furnishing usual undertaking that in case the Appellant succeeds in this Appeal, the Applicant Nos.1 and 2/Claimants would refund the said amount along with interest as would be directed by this Court. The Tribunal shall invest remaining amount of compensation with nationalized bank giving highest interest from time to time.
