3. Our attention is invited to the paragraph No.15 in the order dated 9th January 2025 passed by this Court in Suo Motu Public Interest Litigation No. 3 of 2023. The relevant portion of

“15. We are of the opinion that *within six months from today, the Bakery units needs to be directed to stop using wood and coal and by converting these units to use CNG, Gas or Green Fuels etc... ..*”
