1. Heard learned Advocate for the Applicants/original Respondent Nos.1 and 2.
2. The Claims Tribunal–Pune as per the Award dated 14th March 2024 has pleased to direct them to pay a compensation of Rs.15,24,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Lakh Twenty Four Thousand). The Claim against the Opponent Nos.3 to 5 was dismissed.
