1. The above Interim Application is filed to set aside the order dated 5th February 2024, passed by the Registrar ("Judicial-I"), under which the above Writ Petition was dismissed for non removal of office objections.

2. The above Application has been filed after one year and four months of the passing of the said order. It is the case of the Petitioner that since the

portal did not show that there were any office objections, they were unaware that office objections were to be removed. Hence, the delay.

3. Though we are not fully satisfied with the aforesaid explanation, in order to ensure that the Petitioner is not denied an opportunity to raise their grievances on merits, we hereby recall the order dated 5th February 2024 and restore the above Writ Petition to the file of this Court.
