1. This application is filed by the wife seeking cancellation of bail. The anticipatory bail application was granted to the husband by the Sessions Court on 8 November 2024.

Mr. Shah, the learned Advocate appearing on behalf of the Applicant, submits that the Anticipatory Bail Application was filed on 28 June 2024, and ad-interim relief was granted, and ultimately, the husband's Anticipatory Bail Application was allowed.
