1) Petitioners i.e. husband, father-in-law and mother-in-law of Respondent No.2, have filed this Petition for quashing of C.R. No.0171 of 2024 dated 2nd March, 2024, registered with Kandiwali (W), Police Station, Mumbai, under Sections 498(A), 377, 406, 323, 506 and 504 read with 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3 and 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act with the consent of Respondent No.2, the informant.
