1. On the last date, initially learned Advocate for the Petitioner-Complainant has not appeared. He appeared subsequently though VC. Today no one is present.
2. The Court of JMFC, Kalyan has issued process on 06.08.2016 for an offence punishable under Sections 430, 452, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code against in all four accused person.
3. They have preferred Criminal Revision No. 130 of 2016. The

Court of the Additional Sessions Judge Kalyan as per order dated 10.10.2024 has set aside the order of issuance of the process and complaint stands dismissed. This petition challenges the said order.

4. In fact, the order passed by the revisional court is a revisable order. The revision at the instance of the Complainant will be maintainable. This Court has reason to note that the revision was not preferred by the Complainant but by the accused.

5. Writ petition is not proper remedy. Hence, the Writ Petition is dismissed. Liberty is granted to the Petitioner to take appropriate steps.
