1. By this Petition, the Petitioner, who claims to be the father of the child at issue, has sought issuance of a Writ of Habeas Corpus.

Respondent No.2 is the maternal uncle, Respondent No.3 is the maternal aunt, and Respondent No.4, is the maternal grandmother.

4. All the parties have signed every page of the consent terms. The respective signatories are present in Court and have been identified by their respective Advocates. It is agreed that the child will be handed over to the custody of the Petitioner. All signatories assure the Court that they will not resile from the agreed terms and will ensure that the terms are implemented.
