1. Heard Mr. Vagal, learned Advocate, for the Petitioner.
2. During pendency of the Application filed under Section 143A of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, learned 5th Judicial Magistrate First Class, Kolhapur on 29.11.2024 directed Accused Nos. 1 to 3 to pay jointly and severally 10% of the amount of the cheque by way of an interim compensation. This Order was challenged by the Petitioner who is the Original Accused No. 2 before the Revisional Court which was dismissed on 01.07.2025 by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Kolhapur.
3. Learned Judge has not considered the parameters laid down in

the case of *Rakesh Ranjan Shrivastava vs. The State of Jharkhand & anr.* passed in *Criminal Appeal No. 741 of 2024*.

4. Issue notice to Respondent No. 2 returnable on **26.08.2025**.
