1) In pursuance of Order dated 14<sup>th</sup> August 2025, the Petitioner had in fact deposited the amount of cost of Rs. 25,000/- within stipulated period. conceded the fact that, it is due to his either inadvertence or mistake, the said cheque has been dishonored. We accept the said statement.

2.1) Mr. Hagare submitted that, the Petitioner will now pay the said cost by way of demand draft within a period of one week from today. The said statement is accepted.
