Mr. Anvay Homkalas, the learned counsel for the petitioners states that in Writ Petition No. 3957 of 2025 titled "*Mahim Pramod Vyas v. Vijay Machhindra Shinde & Ors.*" filed by the co-accused Mahim Pramod Vyas, this Court (Coram: A.S. Gadkari and Ranjitsinha Raja Bhonsale, JJ.) granted indulgence in the matter and stayed further proceedings in C.C. No.11942/PS/2024 qua the said petitioner.
