1. Heard learned Advocate for the Appellant/First-Informant.
2. On her written complaint dated 24th May 2025, addressed to the Senior Police Inspector, Kharadi Police Station, Pune, the FIR came to be registered against the Respondent No.1. The FIR is registered under Section 3(1)(s)(r) of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (“**SC & ST Act**”) and under Section 352 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (“**BNS**”).
3. The Court of Additional Sessions Judge–Pune has granted an

anticipatory bail on 24th July 2025. The Appellant contends that the findings are perverse and need to be interfered with by this Court.

4. Issue notice to Respondent No.1 returnable on **17th November 2025**. Let notice be served through local Police.
