1) Applicants i.e. husband (Applicant No.1); father-in-law (Applicant No.2); mother-in-law (Applicant No.3) and brother-in-law (Applicant No.4) of the Respondent No.2, have filed this Application under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for quashing of C.C. No.6701102/PW/2021, pending on the file of the Judicial Magistrate First Class (Court No.67), Borivali, Mumbai, arising out of C. R. No.698 of 2019, registered with Dindoshi Police Station, Mumbai, dated 20th December 2019, under Sections 498-A, 406, 323, 504, 506 read with 34 of the Indian

Penal Code, with the consent of the Respondent No.2, the informant.
