1. Heard Mr. Chetan Deshmukh, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Ms. Anamika Malhotra, learned APP for the State.

By the present Application filed under section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short “BNSS”), the Applicant is seeking regular bail in Crime No. 164 of 2024 registered with Gangapur Police Station, Nashik for the offences punishable under Section 406, 409, 420 of the Indian Penal Code.
