1. Heard Mr. Akshay Bankapur, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Mr. Khan, learned APP for the Respondent.

2. By the present application the Applicant is seeking bail in C.R. No. 120/2023 registered with Panchavati Police Station Nashik.

3. Mr. Khan, learned APP points out to the Order dated 14<sup>th</sup> June 2024, passed by this Court in Bail Application No.1721/2024
