By the present Application filed under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (“**BNSS**” for short), the Applicant is before this Court seeking regular bail in connection with Crime No. 396 of 2023 registered with Chandan Nagar Police Station for the offence punishable under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (“**IPC**” for short).
