1. Heard Mr. Rokade, learned Advocate for the Applicant and Mr. Gaikwad, learned APP for State.

By the present Application filed under section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short “BNSS”), the Applicant is seeking regular bail in Crime No. 331 of 2024 registered with Adgaon Police Station for the offences punishable under Section 65(1), 64(2), 351(2) of the Bharatiya Nyay Sanhita, 2023 (for short “BNS”) and under Section 6,10, 12 of the POCSO Act.
