1. Heard Mr. Rahul Dhaygude, learned Advocate for the Applicant. He submits that involvement of the accused Hemant alias Tilya Vyankat Kambale in the present crime is similar to the involvement of present Applicant. He points out to page no. 128 of the paper-book, i.e., the statement of Akshay Balaso Jadhav in support of his said contention.
