2. This is an Application filed by Applicant seeking Anticipatory Bail in connection with C.R. No. 0649 of 2024 on 08.12.2024 registered with Rabale Police Station for the offences punishable under Sections 118(2), 3 (5), 351(2) and 352 of Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita.
