Mr. Patil, learned APP submits that as per the direction given by this Court by its order dated 3rd February, 2025, the Senior Police Inspector Mr. Patange and Deputy Commissioner of Police Mr. Rajkumar Shinde are present today in Court. He submits that the Deputy Commissioner of Police Mr. Shinde has specifically instructed him that he will take into account the pen-drives supplied by the Advocate for the Applicant and verify the contents of the same and will accordingly take action. For the said reason

he requires a week time. He also submits that as per direction given by this Court, four accounts of the Applicant have been de-freezed.
