Mr.Najmi, learned counsel for the applicant submits that as per the FIR, the amount is Rs.72,50,000/- was paid by the first informant in the year 2010. He submits that the earlier bail application was dismissed by the Sessions Court, this Court and the Supreme Court. However, the demand draft of Rs.40 lacs was accepted by the first informant and the balance amount of Rs.32,50,000/- has been deposited by the present applicant before the Sessions Court.
