This application is filed for pre-arrest bail under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 in connection with Crime No. 0011/2025 dated 5th January, 2025 registered with Wanvadi Police Station, Pune for the offences punishable under Sections 340(2), 338, 336(3), 319(2), 318(4) read with Section 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.
