

in favour of one Mr. Sahu for a period of 11 months in the year 2020 accepting deposit of Rs.11,50,000/- and compensation/rent of Rs. 3,50,000/- per month. A crime bearing no. 334 of 2021 was registered against the Mr. Sahu under the provisions of The Immoral Traffic (prevention) Act, 1956.

4. Mr. Tripathi, learned counsel for the applicant seeks liberty to add the first informant as party respondent no.2.

5. Liberty granted as prayed for. Amendment to be carried out forthwith. If the amendment is not carried out forthwith, the anticipatory bail application will be dismissed without further reference to this Court.

6. APP to serve a copy of the anticipatory bail application upon the newly added respondent no.2 through the investigating officer.

7. Issue notice to newly added respondent no. 2 returnable on **27 March 2025**. Apart from Court notice, advocate for the applicant is permitted to serve the respondent no.2 by advocate's private notice by all permissible modes of service and file affidavit of service to that effect before the next date of the hearing. Details of Crime No.334 of 2021, should be filed before the next date of hearing.

8. Stand over to **27 March 2025**, matter to come up under the

caption “**For Urgent Hearing**”.
