1. Mr. Haridas, appearing for the applicant seeks liberty to add the first informant as party respondent No. 2. Liberty as prayed is granted. Amendment to be carried out forthwith. It is made clear that if the amendment is not carried out, the anticipatory bail application will stand dismissed without further reference to this Court.

2. Issue notice to newly added respondent No. 2, returnable on **28th April, 2025**. Matter to come up under the caption of '**Urgent Circulation**'.

3. Apart from the Court notice, the applicant is also permitted to serve the respondent No. 2 by private service, by all permissible modes of service and file affidavit of service before the next date of hearing.

4. Stand over to **28th April, 2025.**
5. Matter to come up under the caption of **'Urgent Circulation'**.
6. Since Mr. Haridas has made a statement that the protection granted to the present applicant during the pendency of the pre-arrest bail application before the Sessions Court, no coercive steps be taken against the present applicant till the next date of hearing.
