1. At the outset, Mr. Mangaonkar, learned APP states that the Applicants are not attending the Police Station, although, they have been called on three occasions.

5. Learned Counsel for the Applicants tenders short Affidavit on behalf of the Applicants in response to the Additional documents filed by the Respondent No.2.

6. Stand over to **10th November 2025**. Till next date, ad-interim protection already granted shall remain in operation.
