5. The learned counsel for the applicant further submits that the applicant is ready to deposit a sum of Rs. 2 Lakhs in this Court within a period of two weeks. Since the applicant is desirous to deposit a sum of Rs. 2 Lakhs in this Court without prejudice to the rights and contentions, he is permitted to do so.

6. Subject to the applicant depositing the said sum of Rs.2 Lakhs in this Court within a period of two weeks from today, no coercive steps be taken against the present applicant till the next date of the hearing.
