The applicant is willing to cooperate with the investigation by furnishing all relevant investment details to the Investigating Officer and by appearing at the concerned police station. She is also ready to surrender

the mobile phone allegedly used in the commission of the crime.

2. The learned APP seeks time to take instructions and assures the Court that the applicant shall not be arrested in connection with the present crime until the next date. In the meantime, the applicant shall report to the concerned police station, cooperate with the investigation, and surrender the mobile phone purportedly used in the commission of the offence.
