1. Heard learned counsel for the Applicant and learned APP for the State.
2. By this application, the Applicant is seeking relaxation of condition imposed by this Court (Coram: Prakash D. Naik, J) vide order dated 8th July, 2021. While suspending the sentence that the Applicant shall not enter into jurisdiction of Andheri (E) and Marol

and he shall not visit the Uttam Dhaba till the further orders.

3. Learned counsel for the Applicant submits that the Applicant has been convicted by the trial Court and he is on bail. The Applicant stays in Andheri (E) and his mother stays in Marol. He required to enter into the said jurisdiction. Hence, requested to allow the application.

4. Learned APP strongly objected to allow the application on the ground that the Applicant had tried to kill the first informant, if condition is relaxed, he may create nuisance to the first informant. Hence, requested to reject the application.

5. I have heard both learned counsel.

6. The Applicant is convicted by the trial Court. While suspending the order, this Court has imposed the condition on the Applicant, the Applicant shall not enter into jurisdiction of Andheri (E) whereas his mother stays in Marol. Considering these facts, I pass following order:-

ORDER

- i. Application is allowed.
- ii. The condition imposed on the Applicant shall not enter into jurisdiction of Andheri(E) and Marol is

relaxed.

iii. The Applicant shall not visit the Uttam Dhaba till
the further order.

7. In view of the above, the application stands disposed of.
